POSTION DESCRIPTION

Under the direction of the Vice President for Student Affairs and Dean of Students, plan, organize, and direct the operations of SCS, including the following tasks: develop the SCS budget; provide a variety of mental health services to appropriately respond to students' acute and chronic psychological problems, promote mental health among the students, ease the adjustment to academic life and assist in student retention and success; assist in administration and supervision of the post- and pre-doctoral psychology training programs; and supervise and evaluate the performance of assigned personnel and psychology trainees.

Any combination equivalent to: Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical or Counseling Psychology plus two years of postlicensure experience in a college or university counseling center including two years of progressive administrative/supervisory experience in a college or university counseling center.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Three to five years years of progressive administrative/supervisory experience in a college or university counseling center.

Three to five years of post-licensure experience in a college or university counseling center.
