Position Description: Psychologist Counseling and Health Services

General

Drexel University Counseling Center (DUCC) has an opening for a licensed psychologist to provide direct psychological services to undergraduate and graduate students on the Center City and University City campuses of Drexel University. DUCC operates two sites, the largest of which is on the University City Campus. Our second site, located on our Center City campus, is easily accessible via our university shuttle service. The successful candidate must possess a PhD or PsyD in Clinical or Counseling Psychology and have experience providing supervision for trainees. The candidate must be licensed to practice in Pennsylvania, or be eligible for a temporary license while the state completes is licensing process. Drexel University is located in the heart of Philadelphia, a major multicultural destination that brings art, history and culture together with its assorted selection of museums, theatres, restaurants, sports arenas, and music venues for year round entertainment. It is within easy traveling distance to New York City and Washington D.C. as well as the Pocono Mountains recreational area and the Jersey Shore.

Education & Experience:

A Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical or Counseling Psychology. APA accredited training/internship and counseling center experience preferred. PA Licensed or license eligible within probationary period. If not licensed in PA, proof of passing EPPP exam. Two years of post-degree experience providing personal counseling, crisis intervention, assessment and consultation to late adolescent/early adult population or undergraduate and graduate students in a college or university setting (internship acceptable) preferred. Supervisory experience required. Special interest in and experience with group therapy a plus. Multicultural sensitivity and an understanding of the needs of non-traditional students a must. Excellent counseling, crisis intervention and communication skills required; must have good organizational and computer skills.

General Description of Duties:

This is a 12 month, full-time Counseling Center Staff position. This position will provide direct client care to students at Drexel University, a large (25,000 pop) private institution located in Philadelphia, PA. In addition, this person will function as an experienced supervisor, someone with a passion for developing early career clinicians and with a facility for teaching clinical judgment to junior peers. This person will also engage in consultation services; provide supervision of pre-doctoral interns and/or practicum students, share on-call responsibilities with full time staff; and, participate in general Student Affairs functions as a member of an Office within the Division of Student Affairs.

Counseling Responsibilities: Essential Functions of Position

- Provide individual, group and couples counseling
- Provide supervision to junior staff, doctoral interns, and externs
- Provides education in areas of expertise for the didactic seminar for doctoral interns
- Participate in walk-ins, which includes providing triage assessments and consultation and
- Carries the department on-call cell phone for one week approximately every nine weeks

- Provide consultation to faculty, staff and administration regarding students.
- Participate in the Counseling Center's prevention and intervention efforts through campuswide outreach efforts
- Maintain APA professional ethics in all areas.
- Participate in weekly clinical supervision.
- Participates in Counseling Center and university –wide meetings /committees as needed
- One evening hour is required
- Additional tasks as assigned by Assoc Dean of Students, Counseling & Health.
